You have just purchased a PM5090 Pedestal Roller. This product was specifically designed for use as a work support allowing safer, more convenient material handling while operating jointers, planers, bandsaws and other machines.

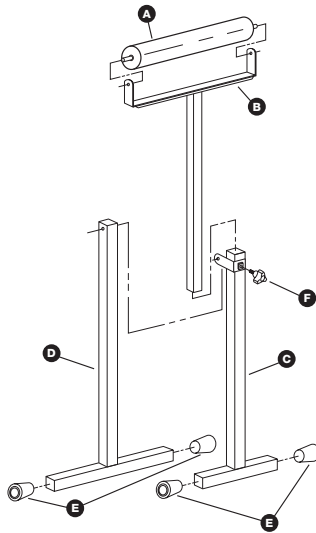
General Safety Instructions for Power Tools

1. Know your power tool. Read and understand the owner's manual and observe the warnings and instruction labels affixed to the tool.
2. Properly ground all tools.
3. Keep guards in place.
4. Remove adjusting keys and wrenches.
5. Keep work area clean and dry.
6. Keep children away.
7. Never leave running machines/tools unattended.
8. Disconnect tools to service.
9. Regularly maintain tools.
10. Use correct tools for the job.
11. Never force a tool.
12. Wear safe apparel
13. Use safety glasses/goggles.
14. Never stand or sit on tools.
15. Replace damaged components immediately.

Assembly Instructions

Tools needed: (2) 7/16" wrenches and a putty knife.

1. Unpack and make certain all parts and hardware are included and are not damaged from shipment.
2. Install rubber tips onto the ends of the T-Leg and support leg. Start the tip onto the tube by rotating in a circular fashion. Once started, tap the tube and tip against the floor to complete installation.
3. Attach Support Leg (D) to the T-Leg (C) using 1/4" - 20 x 1 1/2" hex bolt and self-locking nut.
4. Insert Roller T (B) into the T-Leg (C) and secure with 5/16"-18 Point Knob (F).
5. Install Roller (A) into Roller Tee (B) by first inserting the fixed (non-spring loaded) end of the axle into one hole of the Roller Tee (B). Then using a putty knife like a shoe horn, slide the other end of the roller into position — the axle will snap into place.
